Katikati is New Zealand's largest open air art gallery and is located in the Bay of Plenty, in the North Island of New Zealand, and is situated on State Highway 2, between the city of Tauranga in the south and the township of Waihi in the north.

Katikati was established in 1875 by George Vesey Stewart, and was the largest Ulster Settlement in New Zealand. Hence we use the yellow Ulster tartan.

Katikati enjoys an agreeable temperate climate and is a major Kiwifruit and Avocado growing area.

Registration is at St Peter's Anglican Church, cnr Beach Rd & Carisbrooke St.

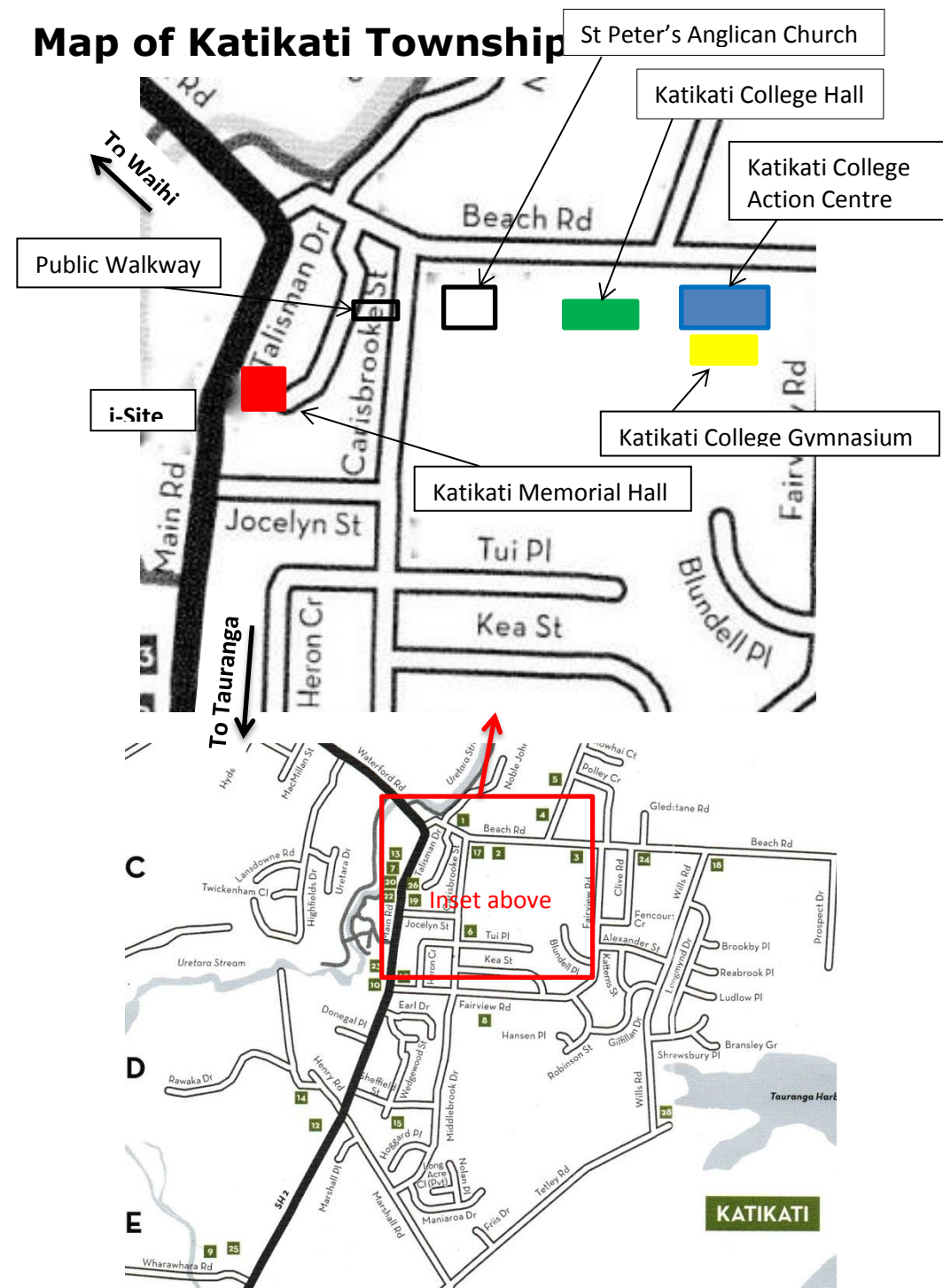

CLASS SELECTION GUIDE

Elementary – Mary Thomas (Katikati College Gymnasium)

This class is for first and second year dancers, who understand basic steps and formations, and wish to improve their dancing technique. The class is geared towards adults; however young dancers 12 years and over who are disciplined enough to share a class with adults are welcome.

Intermediate / Mainstream – Olina Carter (Katikati College Action Centre)

This class is for dancers who have moved beyond Elementary and are dancing competently. Emphasis will be placed on refining steps, formations, phrasing and positioning, and relating socially to others in your and adjacent sets.

Advanced Low Impact – David Williamson (Katikati College Hall)

This class is for dancers who have moved beyond Intermediate / Mainstream, have been dancing a number of years, and are competent dancers, except that they are physically unable to maintain the elevation and precision of steps normally required of an advanced dancer.

Advanced Technique – Gail Schofield (Katikati Memorial Hall)

This class is for competent dancers who wish to do less common formations and be challenged and extended to improve their technique and precision. Dancers must be able to sustain a high level of performance for the whole duration of the class/es.

Musician's Class – Lynne Scott (Katikati Memorial Hall Lounge)

The class will cover basic techniques of playing as a Band, and will include the Scottish styles of March, Jig, Reel and Strathspey. Basic music reading skills are assumed, but music will be sent ahead of time. For those who wish, the class may play for some dancing at the Sunday evening Ceilidh.

Suitable instruments include violin (fiddle), accordion, piano/keyboard, flute, cello. For other instruments, please contact Lynne for further information: lynne@scott.gen.nz
Participants in the Music class do not need to be dancers. If your fingers work you are welcome!

Young dancers from about 12 years upwards are welcome to join any class on the recommendation of their regular tutor.
