# Notice of Motion for the Determination of Membership Fees for 2024/25

The Management Committee proposes that the New Zealand Branch Service Fee for 2024/25 for an Adult Single Member remains at \$55 as agreed at the AGM 1 January 2023. The Society Subscription (expressed in Pounds) will be that set by the Society at its AGM in November 2023, and the Management Committee will determine in July 2024 what that amount will be when converted to NZ\$.
