Ripples on the Lagoon

32 bar jig for three couples in a three-couple longwise set

1-4 1st couple set turning to face 2nd couple at the end of bar 4, as 2nd couple face up

5-8 1^{st} and 2^{nd} couples set twice, facing up and down on the side

9-16 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} couples dance reels of three on the side – 1^{st} couple dancing in and down to begin, 2^{nd} couples out and up, and 3^{rd} couple in and up

17-20 1st couple lead down the middle for 2 steps, lead up for 2

21-24 1^{st} couple cast down to 3^{rd} place, 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} couples moving up on bars 23 and 24

25-32 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 1^{st} couples dance six hands round and back

Repeat with a new top couple.

Suggested music: "Jig Medley" recorded by Bobby Brown on "Grandfather Mountain Gala"

Published in the Milford Collection - dances devised by Milford Juniors, 2002. Lois McEwan was introducing the group to mirror reels and the rest of the dance just followed. One junior came up with the descriptions of the various bars:

- 1-8 Bullrushes blowing in the wind
- 9-16 Ripples on the water
- 17-24 Waves
- 15-32 Edge of the lagoon.

Dance Devisors Competition

Closing date for submissions is 10 November 2104. Evaluation will take place worldwide during December 2014 to March 2015 with the final winner announced on 19 April 2015.
